## **Instructions for Arrow of Light Plaque**

## Materials List:

**Back Plate:** 3/4" X 8" X 36" – Red Oak or other high quality wood.

Arrow of Light Symbol 1/4" x 6" X 36" Red Oak or other high quality wood.

- **Brass Eye-Screws** Two per plaque. Make sure the eye is large enough for the arrow to pass through <u>after</u> the career arrow is completed.
- **Brass Name Plate**, Engraved or photo-printed with *Name*, *Pack Number*, *AOL* and year. Attach with adhesive tape or small screws. Look for local trophy / awards providers for name plates.
- <u>Wooden-shaft Arrow</u>. Wood works best. You are able to see the colors against the neutral background. Check with local archery shops. (Westown Archery will make Cub Scout Arrows with Blue and Yellow fletching.)
- <u>Misc Supplies</u> Sandpaper (Course to Fine), Paint Brushes, Stain, Satin Polyurethane Varnish, Finishing Nails, Wood Glue, and Picture Hanging Hardware of your choice.


Make a template of the AOL symbol using poster board and the pattern attached. Cut out the template and use it to trace (with pencil) the pattern onto 1/4" x 6" x36" wood. Cut the AOL symbol out using band saw, jigsaw, or scroll saw (Be aware that it will take time to complete all of these cuts). Sand and apply satin polyurethane vanish. Let dry completely.

Using a router, rout the edges on the face side of the 3/4" x 8" x 36" wood board. Sand the wood until smooth on all faces and edges. Apply **Minwax** "*Red Sedona*" stain, and let dry completely. Apply satin polyurethane varnish and let dry completely.

Lightly glue and nail AOL symbol onto face of 3/4" x 8" x 36" piece of wood. Place eye screws at equidistant apart on the arrow portion of the AOL symbol. Attach name plate under AOL symbol, centered on the back plate. Add career arrow to plaque.
